



Physical Therapy Compact Commission Lifts Colorado Suspension

Alexandria, VA, February 9, 2018 – At a special meeting of the Physical Therapy Compact Commission, Delegates unanimously voted to lift the state of Colorado’s suspension. Colorado’s status as a member state was officially reinstated with full membership privileges.

After discussion the Commission deemed the recent action taken by the State of Colorado sufficient to cure the prior default that led to the vote to suspend on June 14, 2017. Colorado is now working with the Commission staff on implementing the rules and processes needed to begin issuing compact privileges in the near future.
