### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 11:33 AM ET.

#### Approve April 3, 2025 Minutes

Minutes approved.

#### Audit of Compact Member State Board Websites

Committee members were assigned Compact member states to audit state board websites for PT Compact information. The audit found that compact privilege holders were not included in the state licensure lookup websites for at least 13 active member states. At least 2 member states did include a link to the PT Compact privilege verification website, which is considered the primary source for Compact Privilege verification. A concern was raised regarding recent changes in credentialing standards by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) which is causing pressure on large provider systems to verify practitioners. Thus, it was concluded that prompt education and outreach to state boards on this issue is essential. The committee discussed recommendations for Compact member state boards to either include compact privilege holders in their licensure lookup sites and/or provide a direct link to the PT Compact privilege verification website on the board's website. Staff to follow up on the request.

## **Social Media Posts**

The committee reviewed content on scheduled weekly posts from PT Compact social media accounts for the rest of 2025. No changes requested. Committee members to provide staff with additional recommendations for content for social media posts.

# Change in Home State Video

The committee reviewed a draft of the Change in Home State video and provided staff with recommended changes, including separating the content into two separate videos. A third video clarifying "What defines Home State" was also recommended.

# Other Potential Videos

The committee briefly discussed options for how to create additional educational/marketing videos, including potentially using an external video production company to create custom animated videos.
